General Description

The Seasonal Barista is part of the General Store team; it is a part-time or full-time flex, non-benefited position, responsible for greeting customers, answering their questions, taking orders, preparing, and serving food and drinks. Shifts will vary and will include a mix of weekdays and weekends. For emergency and inclement weather reporting, this position is considered essential.

Major Duties and Responsibilities

- Welcoming customers, informing them about specials or new items, answering their questions, and accepting orders and payments.
- Prepares a variety of hot, iced, and blended drinks using espresso machine, commercial blender, and other kitchen equipment.
- Knows and complies consistently with our standard portion sizes, recipe cards, preparation methods, quality standards and rules, policies, and procedures.
- Maintains a clean and sanitary workstation area including tables, shelves, utensils, and equipment.
- Assists in food prep and packaging assignments during off-peak periods as needed.
- Preparing foods, such as sandwiches or baked goods and handles, stores and rotates products properly and in adherence with all food safety regulations.
- Utilizes POS system and performs open and/or close procedures as needed.
- Cleaning and restocking work areas, emptying trash, and sanitizing equipment and utensils.
- Updating signage and displays to attract customers.
- Taking inventory and replenishing items in display cases and behind the counter.
- Works as part of a fun, high-energy team.

Knowledge/Skills/Experience

- Hands on experience with making high quality specialty coffee and tea drinks
- Basic math skills, experience receiving and processing credit cards a plus
- Exceptional listening and communication skills
- Ability to walk and bend, and stand for extended periods
- Availability to work around peak hours, including nights, early mornings, weekends, and holidays
- A polite, engaging personality
- Commitment to customer satisfaction and service excellence
- Willingness to work as part of a high-energy, efficient team in a fast-paced environment.
